This count is not subject to reduction after the seven-day deadline. 1912 will set up and be prepared to serve 5% over this guarantee. If no guarantee is received, 1912 will determine the guarantee to be the number shown on the menu contract.

Additional lunch, cocktail, and dinner guests are welcome. All volunteers having meals are to be included in the final numbers. Additional guests will be charged accordingly.

The guaranteed minimum number of people anticipated assigned rooms. Room rental fees are applicable if group attendance drops below the estimated attendance at the time of booking. The 1912 Club reserves the right to change the location of rooms due to weather.

The Engager assumes all responsibility for damage and hereby indemnifies and holds harmless the Club for any and all expenses arising from damage done to the Club's property by any participant in the function.

Parking of cars will be at the guests' own risk. The Club is not responsible for damages to any car or personal property left therein. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen articles at the club or in car.

The 1912 Club prohibits any donated food or beverage products to be distributed on the course during your outing. The patron, guests, or invitees cannot bring beverages of any kind into 1912 under any circumstance.

The 1912 Club does not permit the sale of alcohol to minors or those who appear to be intoxicated.

A Cordless in-house microphone system is available.

Any special audio or visual needs must be communicated two weeks prior to your event. Smoking is prohibited in the clubhouse or on the patio. Smoking is allowed on the lawn.

Cancellation Policy

Notice of cancellations, regardless of when it is received by 1912, shall result in a forfeit of deposit money. If the outing cancels due to weather, but the course is playable, the outing forfeits the deposit. If the outing cancels within 7 days of the event, the outing will be held responsible for the cost of food.

1912 reserves the right at any time prior to or during the outing to cancel at the sole discretion of the Superintendent, shall the golf course be deemed unplayable due to weather or an act of God. 1912 may restrict the use of carts or close the course due to the weather or course conditions.

If the Superintendent cancels the outing because the course is unplayable, the outing has the option to

- 1. Reschedule the outing at a mutually agreeable date.
- 2. Receive a full refund of the deposit.

Golf Details

Golf pairings are due Friday prior to the outing.
We require all golfers to wear proper golf attire
(No short shorts, denim, collarless shirts, or tank tops are permitted. Shirts are to be tucked in).
The 1912 Club is a soft spike facility. No metal spikes are permitted.
The Pro Shop will gladly arrange custom logo apparel or golf balls.

Financial Details

Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of \$5,000 will reserve your date. The amount for the outing based on the per-person minimum number is due the morning of the event. If there are other incidental charges, such as beverages, you will receive an invoice after the event. Payment is due within 7 days of the event.
